While "experts" technically refer to aquifers in "acre feet". This makes it harder to comprehend vs. simpler gallon per resident calculations. (U.S. Census, and AZ Dept. Water Res.)

*More Water Demand, Means Water Wells Drop Faster.

Water Well NEWS: Kingman already has (1) well in G.V., with a 2nd well drill planned. Sadly, Golden Valley's "Sacramento Water Aquifer" is NOT regulated the same as other Aquifers in AZ. So it appears to be a "Free For All" scramble to grab water...!

- ***Land Use:** Most GV residents want to preserve the original ONE house per 1.1 acre plan for Golden Valley, as <u>much as possible</u>. By Mohave County approving Angle Homes at several houses per acre, this <u>sets a PRECEDENT for the next 10 Years</u>. Opens doors for even more high density developments.
